





Agreement #1 – HAZUS FIT Demonstration Project

In accordance with the Cooperating Technical Partner (CTP) Memorandum of Agreement dated April 19, 2001, between Johnson County, Kansas and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Mapping Activity Statement # 1 is as follows:


- 1. Objective and Scope:** The objective of this Mapping Activity is to support FEMA's HAZUS Flood Module through the use of the Flood Information Tool (FIT).
- 2. Period of Performance:**
This Mapping Activity will end no later than December 31, 2002. This Mapping Activity may be terminated at the option of FEMA or Johnson County in accordance with the provisions of the April 19, 2001 CTP Memorandum of Agreement.
- 3. Funding/Cost-Sharing:** Federal funds for this activity will be provided by FEMA through a Cooperative Agreement.
- 4. Activities:** Johnson County shall make the following available:
 - Utilize the FIT to collect and modify data necessary to run level 2 or 3 of the HAZUS Flood Module
 - Share processes and information on the FIT website with other FIT communities
 - Provide feedback on the progress of the project to FEMA staff
 - Conclude the data collection and adaptation process before the HAZUS Flood Module is released
- 5. Reporting:** Reporting requirements will be in accordance with Agreement Articles V & VI of the Cooperative Agreement.
- 6. Points of Contact:** The FEMA Project Officer is Robert Franke and the CTP's Project Manager is Kent L. Lage, or subsequent personnel of comparable experience who are appointed to fulfill these responsibilities.

Each party has caused this Mapping Activity Statement to be executed by its duly authorized representatives.
